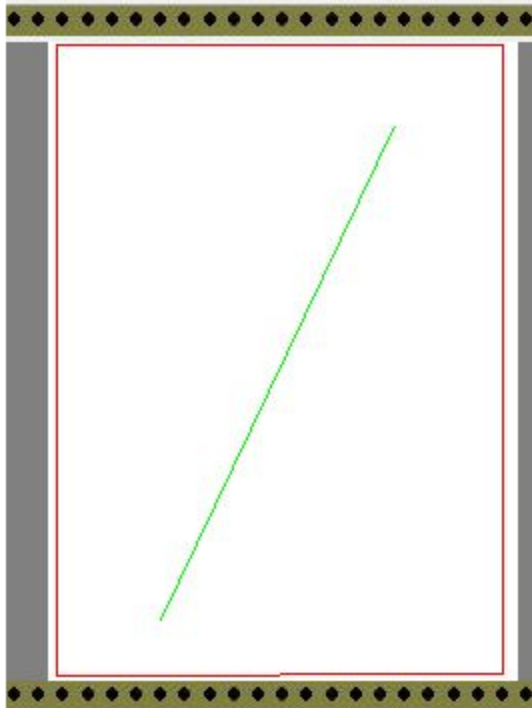




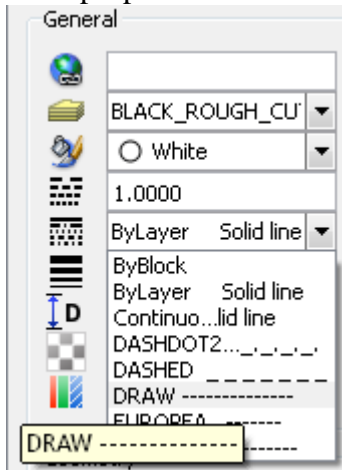
## Drawing on Templates

*Abstract: This document described how to use AllenCAD to draw lines/arcs on a template rather than cut them. You could use this to draw a line for a sink outline rather than cut it. Last update 9-15-14*

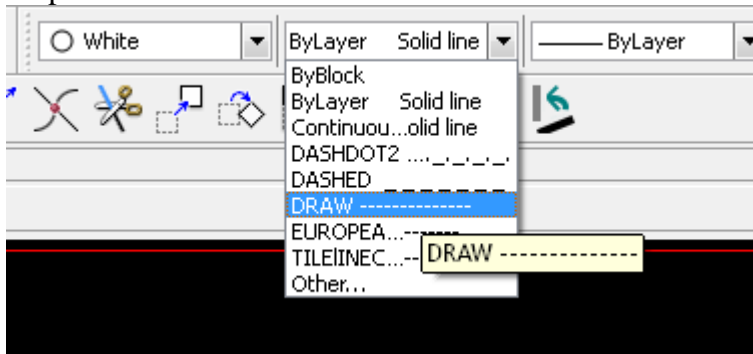
How to draw on template so that color comes out green so it plotted rather than cut.



To change already drawn objects to be green in tile:  
 Select objects you want to be drawn rather than cut.  
 In the properties side bar control select draw for line type



To create new objects with draw line type select DRAW as linetype from the property drop down



lines or arcs create after changing the line type will be drawn rather than cut.  
 Change to linetype bylayer to create cutlines.

To use the different pen colors you have to enable several features in the printer driver and the cutter.

- Multiple pen output must be set to Yes
- Send Force/Speed to tool must be set to Yes
- Green and red pen colors must set so the force or speed you desire is set on the property page of the printer driver.

To get to the property page select the property button next to the printer name in the Allen Auto Tile. Set the options as shown in bold on the next page.
